About Our Guest Artist

Dianna Richardson is the Orchestra Director at Cleveland School of the Arts where she serves as the Music Department Chair. She also directs the All-City Orchestra for the Cleveland Metropolitan School District All-City Arts Program, a district-wide after school and weekend program providing artistic and college readiness skills. Ms Richardson is the director for the Tri-C "TOP" Orchestra Program and the "Strings Attached" summer music camp at Tri-C Metro. She serves as principal bass in the Grammy-award-winning Cleveland Chamber Symphony and received her education from Arizona State, Juilliard, The Cleveland Institute of Music, and Cleveland State University. Ms Richardson holds Bachelors and Masters degrees in Music Performance.

About Our Directors

Carrie Klayman Singler is in her seventeenth year as the Director of Orchestras and as a jazz educator in the Bay Village City Schools. Ms. Singler is the founder and advisor of the Bay High Honors Quintet, the Bay High Rocket Quartet and Bay High School Chamber Orchestra. Outside of Bay she has served as an adjudicator for Greater Cleveland and Lakewood Solo & Ensemble Festivals and as a section coach for OMEA Northeast Region Orchestra and the Mentor Orchestra program.

Mrs. Singler has appeared as a featured soloist with the Cleveland Jazz Orchestra, as a featured chamber musician at the Erie Festival of the Arts, and has appeared in recital with Annie Fullard and Elizabeth DeMio. Mrs. Singler is a founding member of the Obsidian Quartet, PRISM jazz quintet, a member of the Walden Players, and frequent performer with the Amethyst Strings. Her performances have been aired on WCLV Cleveland and WOED Pittsburgh radio. Additionally, she has played with the Akron Symphony, Youngstown Symphony, Warren Philharmonic, Heights Chamber Orchestra, Finnfest Symphony Orchestra, Valley Lyric Opera, Opera Per Tutti (Cleveland Opera Theater), and with Michael Bolton and Gary Puckett

Mrs. Singler holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music where she graduated with distinction, and a Master of Music degree from Cleveland State University. She studied chamber music with members of the Ying and Audubon Quartets and violin with Molly Fung Dumm, Lynn Blakeslee, Marilyn McDonald, David Updegraff, Stephen Majeske and Helen Richards. Her primary jazz teachers have included John Klayman, Harold Danko, David Baker, Rich Armandi and Aidan Plank. Mrs. Singler and her husband live in Bay Village with their two daughters.

Ann Gilbert is a graduate of the Cleveland Institute of Music (B.M.), the Juilliard School of Music (M.M.), and the University of Akron (Ph.D.). Her first bass teachers were George Wisneskey and Harry Barnoff. She studied piano with Marianne Mastics. She studied string bass with David Perlman, principal bass for the Cleveland Orchestra and John Schaeffer, principal bass for the New York Philharmonic.

Her résumé includes appointments as principal bass with the Symphonic Orchestra of the State of Mexico in Toluca, Mexico, assistant principal bass with the Oregon Symphony in Portland, Oregon, and in the Symphonic Orchestra of Seville, Spain.

She has played in orchestras backing up Kenny Rogers, Scott Hamilton, Kenny Loggins, Roger Daltry, Luciano Pavarotti, Jewel, Dennis DeYoung, the Three Tenors, Andrea Bocelli, the Moody Blues and The Who.

Ann has taught music at public and private institutions throughout Northeast Ohio. She currently teaches Suzuki and traditional bass for the Cleveland Music Settlement and the Oberlin Community Music School.

At present, Ann plays principal bass with the Cleveland Pops Orchestra, the Akron Symphony, the BlueWater Chamber Orchestra and as a member of the Firelands Symphony Orchestra.
